### Notes:

- Ms. Jenkinson- meeting with superintendent- about the vision of the district and that decisions about closures and boundary changes will be made in January when the board votes.
- Minutes were approved from October.
- District recommendations for closures and boundary changes were shared last week- they are proposing moving the ELP/Dual-Language program here, which will phase out into Dual-Language only. December 5<sup>th</sup> in the public meeting for comments and questions.
- Ms. Amendola-Francis- All counselors will be on call as of January to help with transition issues at schools that will be closed.
- The afterschool program should expand if the number of students in a school increases.
- SCC Training- we all completed that last meeting. Rules of order procedures will be formally written down soon- we need to work on having the SCC agenda out to members at least a week in advance.
- Call Survey- done in all schools by the staff. Results are in and we will discuss in January. Compared to schools deemed to be like us, we were above average.
- Ms. Amendola-Francis- SHARP Survey results will be shared with Admin, faculty, and then SCC.
- Superintendent's focus for the district is dignity- across SLCSD there is an uptick in inappropriate language use (younger and younger) as well as racial slurs. Nibley has seen this also. Mrs. Battle will put some information in her newsletters about these issues as well as the terms they are learning from Tik-Tok that are often innocent sounding but referencing sexually explicit content so parents are aware and can discuss with their children.
- Ms. Amendola-Francis has three more classes to teach internet safety to and then there will be an evening parent meeting about digital issues.
- Ms. Battle met with 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> graders today to discuss behavior issues and dedication to their education.
- There will only be a meeting on December 14, 2023 if necessary.
