## LCSS VISITOR POLICY

Georgia Law prohibits visitors on a public school campus for social or nonessential reasons. Students are not to bring visitors to school with them or meet visitors around fringe areas of the campus during school hours. Violations of this rule could result in arrest of visitors and serious disciplinary action taken with students. Visitors with specific purposes are welcome and asked to check in with the main office. Visitors should use the front parking lot. To promote uninterrupted instructional time and for the protection and safety of our students, we are following these visitation guidelines:

- 1. All visitors, including parents, are to stop in the office and receive a visitor's pass.
- 2. Appointments will be made for conferences and classroom visitation.
- 3. To prevent interruptions, younger children should not accompany parents during visitations
