The Advent Wreath

The Advent wreath is a beautiful and powerful symbol of everything we celebrate during this season of prayerful waiting. Many of us are probably very familiar with what the Advent wreath symbolizes.

There are four candles. Taken together, the four candles represent the four thousand years of waiting for the coming Messiah on the part of the ancient people of Israel. On each of the four Sundays of Advent another candle is lit. So, week after week, the wreath is bathed in more and greater light as we prepare for the birth of Jesus, the Light of the World.

The wreath is circular in shape. A circle has no beginning and no end. Thus, it stands for God for whom there is no beginning and no end.

The plantings that shape the wreath are green, the color of hope. They represent our hope for the coming of the Lord!

Each week parishioners assist the priest or deacon with the lighting of the candles. This symbolizes the collaboration between clergy and people, Church and world, in living and acting in such a manner as to make all of creation and every person ready for the triple Coming of Jesus: at his birth in Bethlehem, at the end of History in glory, and in each and every present moment of life!

The Advent Wreath is not just a thing of beauty. It represents the hopes and aspirations of every human heart, from the first stirrings of faith in the peoples of ancient Israel to each one of us who gather at Mass during the brief but beautiful Season of Advent.







ADVENT AND THE WREATH

This weekend we celebrate the first Sunday in Advent, and every year I like to begin this season with a short reflection. This time it's about the wreath, written by Maria Rodgers O'Rourke.

"Since the Middle Ages, the Advent wreath has been part of Christian spiritual preparation for Christmas. This tradition emerged from an ancient practice of farmers and laborers who, having completed the season's harvest, used greenery and candles to celebrate the solstice and the coming spring.

The wreath is rich in symbolism for Advent preparation. The light is, of course, that of Jesus Christ, coming to a world so desperately in need of his perfect love. The greenery assures us that no matter the losses or challenges we face, God's love renews any situation, resurrecting that which was thought to be dead.

The wreath's circle symbolizes the Advent journey. As we've discovered in life, the attainment of wisdom and peace is not a linear journey, rather, it is a circular one. We may travel through the same issues many times in life, but when we face these issues with open hearts, we grow ever closer to God. This month, we will journey with Mary and Joseph, the Magi, and Christians around the world and rediscover the light and life of Jesus Christ. Light an Advent wreath this year. Celebrate these blessed days that focus our attention on the reason for the season."
