The North Point National Technical Honor Society's application period will open on December 11, 2023 and will close on January 31, 2024. Applications are available in room 313 and can be picked up before 1st block.

The National Technical Honor Society (NTHS) is an educational non-profit that exists to honor, recognize, and empower students in Career and Technical Education. The goal of the North Point charter is to uphold the national charter and to support the professional growth of its members through philanthropic community projects.

To be considered for the application process students must meet the following requirements:

1. Be a student currently enrolled in a CTE program at NPHS
2. Have at least completed the first semester of your first CTE course
3. Have an overall minimum GPA of at least a 3.0 (unweighted)
4. Have an overall minimum CTE GPA of a 3.0 (unweighted)
5. In addition to these requirements, NTHS adheres to the CCPS criteria for student eligibility.
