OUR MISSION

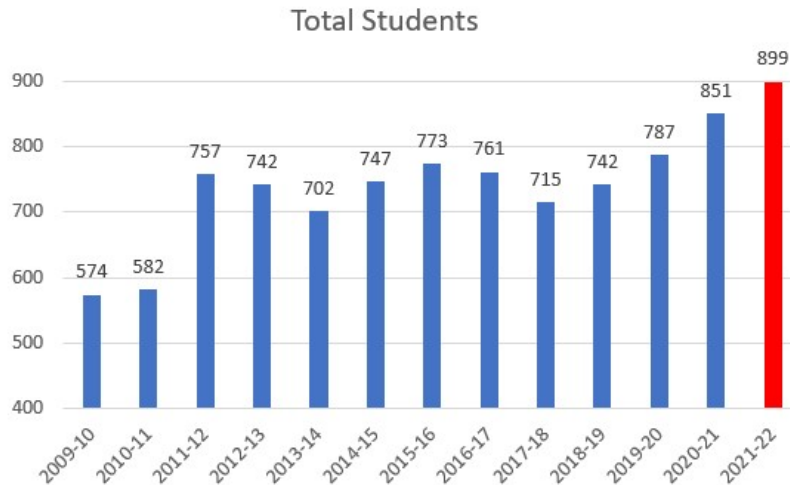

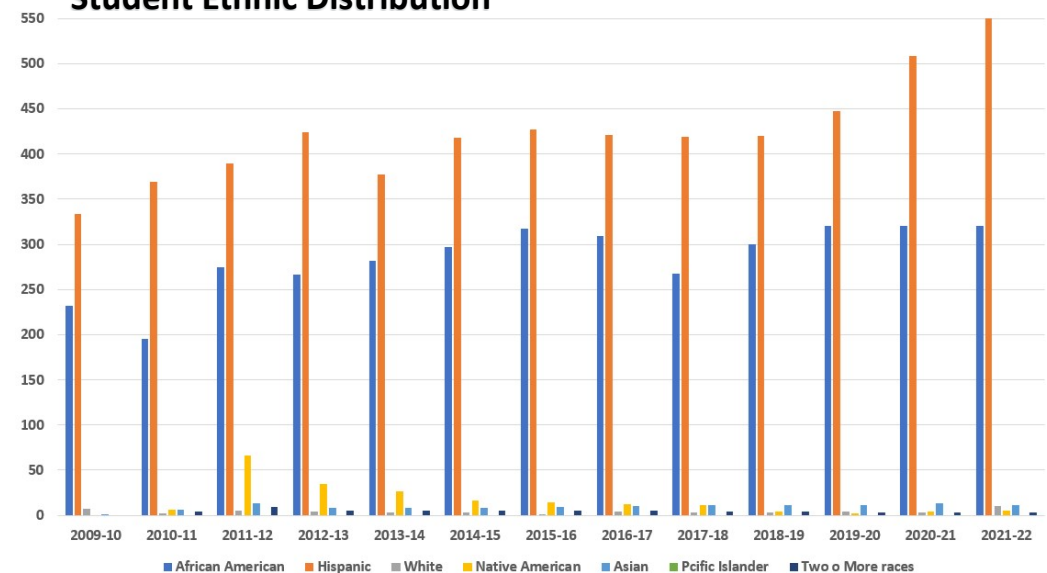

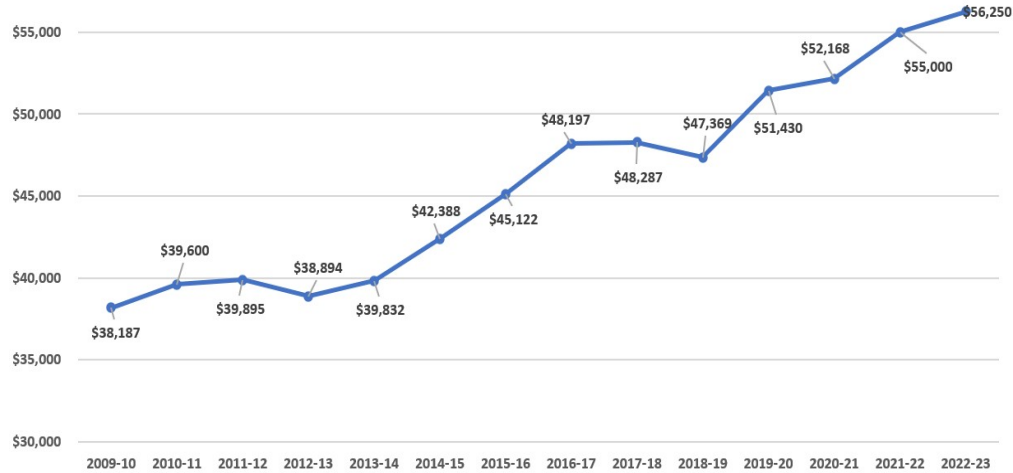

Average Teacher Salary



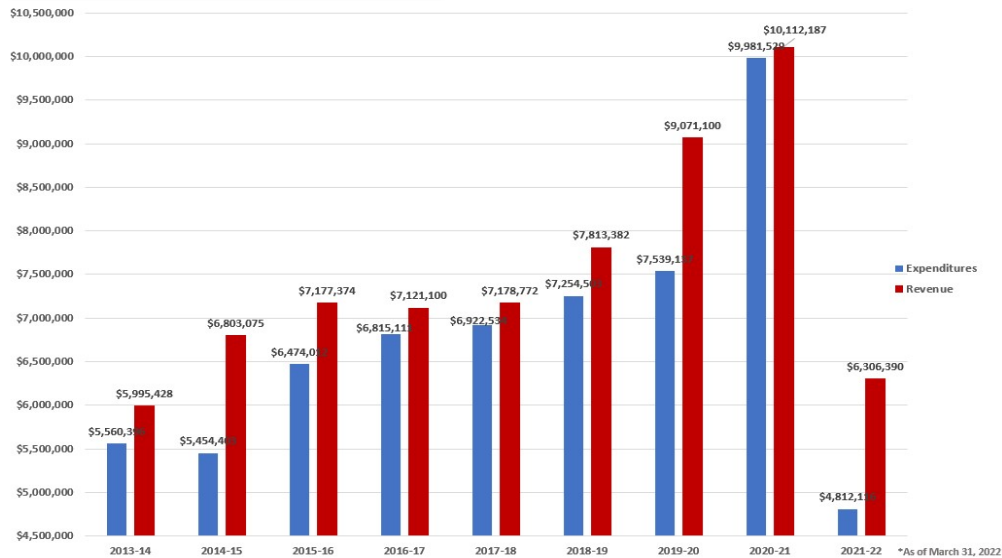
