What is the "Personal Pathway"?

- Students who plan on attending a four-year college should take at least two years of the same World Language in high school.
- Students who plan on joining the military or attending two-year community or technical colleges after high school can take other classes. The classes they choose must align with their postsecondary plans. This is their "Personal Pathway".
- Unsure? Don't close the door on the option of attending a fouryear college!



Additional Graduation Requirements

- ✓ Cumulative 2.0 GPA
- √ 40 hours of community service
- ✓ High School & Beyond Plan
- ✓ WA State History in middle school (7th & 8th grade) or high school
- ✓ State testing requirements for English Language Arts (ELA) and Math


What does Balance mean?

- Utilize "Planning your Schedule" form


Pursue passion area (elective or club)

World Language Considerations

- What level is right for you?
 - Retake level 1 or 2?
- College Pathway:
 - 2 years required, 3-4 recommended
 - 1 year must be in high school
- Competency Test
 - Receive World Language credit
 - Register online and pay the school accountant








AVID

What is it?

- ➤ Year-long elective for motivated students to:
 - raise grades
 - build strategies for high school & college success
- Incorporates study & test taking strategies, organization, note-taking, guest speakers and field trips
- ➤ Participation in AVID *directly* improves grades & learning
- >It will not give you more homework, but it will improve the way you do school



- IF THIS ACADEMIC STANDARD ISN'T MET, INCOMING 9TH GRADERS

 MUST MEET WITH THE HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC DIRECTOR TO:
 - 1. OUTLINE A PLAN FOR ACADEMIC SUCCESS, AND
 - 2. REVIEW ACADEMIC PROBATION REQUIREMENTS THE STUDENT WILL BE HELD TO AS AN ATHLETE.
- THIS MEETING OCCURS DURING THE FIRST TWO WEEKS OF THE FALL SPORTS SEASON FOR FALL STUDENT ATHLETES AND THE FIRST TWO WEEKS OF THE WINTER SPORTS SEASON FOR WINTER STUDENT ATHLETES.


