ASB Card Possession:
 1) In the fall, the school will identify all students who qualify for a free ASB card and issue one to each qualifying student automatically. This includes students that are eligible for FRL (and consented to share data), and students eligible for McKinney Vento services.
 2) The district will create a 1-page informational flier on the benefits of having an ASB card.

Participation:
 1) At the beginning of each athletic season, the school will advertise that participation in athletics is free to any student that qualifies for FRL and consented to share data for fee waivers, or qualifies for McKinney Vento services. In addition, advertise that those that need support in acquiring gear for participation in sports (cleats, baseball glove) can qualify for additional assistance through building support groups. This will be advertised through email, ASB social media, and in-school announcements.
 2) The school will utilize its family connection centers to send targeted communications to students/families that qualify.
