## THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY

Hillsboro, Ohio is located in the gently rolling hills of scenic Highland County, Ohio at the junction of US Highway 50 and US Highway 62.

With a population of 6,605 this quiet town can easily be reached by traveling East from Cincinnati along US Route 50 or by traveling South-West from Columbus on US Route 62. Hillsboro is uniquely positioned 75 minutes from Cincinnati, and Dayton and 90 minutes from Columbus. If you love the outdoors, you will love Hillsboro and the surrounding area. Hillsboro is located just minutes from two state parks, Rocky Fork Lake and Paint Creek Lake.

Hillsboro is home to the annual Fourth of July Festival of Bells and the main campus of Southern State Community College.

The Hillsboro City School District is comprised of 152 sq. miles and includes the city of Hillsboro as well as a large portion of the surrounding rural Highland County area.

## THE SCHOOL DISTRICT

Hillsboro City Schools has made great strides over recent years in providing a strong educational program for its students. On the 2012 state report card, the district received an Excellent rating.

A new preschool through grade 5 facility was opened in 2007-08 school year providing a modern up to date facility. In 2009, Hillsboro opened a new Middle and High School that houses grades 6 through 12. The Elementary, Middle and High School facilities provide students an opportunity to learn and interact in a comfortable and technology enriched environment. All academic classrooms include hearing assistance technology, computers in every room and "Smartboard" technology. The district has approximately 1300 Chromebooks. The facility also includes over 90 video surveillance cameras to monitor activity for the safety of students and staff.
