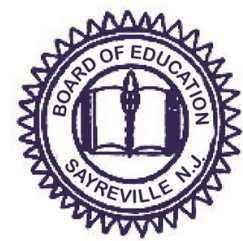

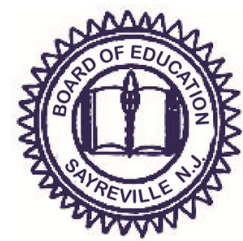


students had a ton of fun painting and cutting their way through fall.
