

HMS Student/Parent Survey Results Summary

Student and parent survey responses have been reviewed and summarized by the middle school Building Leadership Team. Student data supports that nearly all students feel safe at school. They enjoy their friends and believe the teachers and staff are friendly. Many comments were about how our teachers show they care about their students. Students also like the school facilities, building schedule, the course offerings, the extra curricular activities, and the cafeteria food options.

Parents commented that it was easy to meet with staff and communication was not an issue. Parents feel welcome and respected when they come into the building as the staff has been friendly and helpful when encountered.

Overall, comments were very positive about the school and staff despite a few singular incidents. As a school, we plan to continue our PBIS initiative. The survey results showed that students feel confident in knowing the building expectations but the school needs to better explain the initiative to parents. Students felt supported by the staff, teachers, and peers, however, there were a few survey responses that would like to see peer relationships improve. The school will continue to work on building a positive school climate for all students.
