Dress Code & I.D.s

- Students are required to be in dress code daily. Students *may* be placed in ISS for the day if attempts to correct the infraction are unsuccessful.
- These are the **top** dress code infractions: crops tops, slides, ripped jeans with holes 3 in. above the knees, and not wearing student I.D. throughout the day.
- Students **cannot** wear slides during the school day.
- Students I.D.s are to be worn upon entering the building. This is for **safety** of our campus.
- I.D.s should be **visible** on the chest area for the duration of the day.
- A replacement I.D. **must** be obtained from the front desk if the student doesn't have it with them or in the event of it being lost. A fee *will* apply.
- After several dress code infractions, discipline **will** be assigned.

Cellphones

- Cellphones must be placed in the designated spot assigned by the teacher **before** being seated.
- If a student has their phone out during the day, it **may** be confiscated with a \$15 fee at pick-up.
- Serious offenses **may** require a parent to pick it up.
- Campus expectation is that phones are
 "Not seen, Not Heard, Not Taken"
- Students **never** have permission to take photos or record other students anywhere on campus.
- Phones are **prohibited** in restrooms & locker rooms.
- Phones may be turned over to law enforcement for nude/pornographic videos and photos.
- Unauthorized social media posts and accounts are strictly **prohibited**.

Attendance/Tardies

- When checking out or arriving late from a doctor's appointment, a doctor's note must be sent to the attendance office within 3 school days to be excused.
- Online report is for parent notes **only**.
- All doctor's notes need to include a letterhead and signature. NO MyChart or copies of medical bills will be accepted.
- Attendance is taken **every** period at the junior high level. Each period counts as an absence.
- Students are expected to be in their classroom **prior** to the tardy bell ringing.
- Students have **4 minutes** during each passing period.
- **Excessive** tardies will result in disciplinary consequences.
- If a student arrives **after** 15 minutes of the 1st period bell ringing, they will be considered absent.
