Fees and Cancellation Policy

Most Community Ed programs are fee-based programs, as we are selfsupporting. Unless otherwise noted, all necessary materials and supplies are included in the registration fee. When possible, online registration is encouraged. If registering by mail, include fees with the registration form. Checks should be made payable to Parkway-Rockwood Community Ed. Returned payments will be handled in accordance with Rockwood School District finance procedures and applicable fees may apply.

Cancellation of classes/programs will be at the discretion of Community Ed. If a class/program is cancelled due to low enrollment, participants will be notified and receive a full refund. Customer-initiated cancellations made at least three business days prior to start of class or program may qualify for a refund minus a 5% processing fee. Customer-initiated cancellations made two or less business days prior to start of class/program or prior to second meeting of class/program with multiple meeting dates may gualify for a 50% refund. No refunds will be made following the second meeting of class/program.Adventure Club, Rockwood Thunder, Trek & Travel and Early Childhood programs may have separate cancellation policies.
