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**SPOTLIGHT ON STEM** – Each week we will feature a science, technology, engineering, and/or mathematics related lesson or activity occurring at Fenton STEM Academy. In this section of the newsletter, you will find the most recent, innovative, and creative events and activities happening at STEM. This week we are excited to share a lesson that involved our super star second grade students.

The second-grade classes of Mrs. Bell-Reed and Mrs. Marygold have been investigating the Driving Question: How can we use models to understand and describe the land? in their TWIG Science Curriculum! Students have

been studying landforms, and investigating how these landforms were created by nature. After analyzing specific types of landforms, students worked together in teams, to create their own clay model of a landform of their choosing. Students had to agree upon a specific landform and work as a team to manipulate clay to form the landforms. Second grade students will continue to dig deeper, and investigate where water is found in landscapes in the next Driving Question.
