- REMINDER - COVID-19 protocol from Mahoning County Public Health:

ODH recommends schools follow general isolation procedures for confirmed cases. **If students or staff feel sick or suspect they might have COVID-19, they should stay home and be tested. If positive, students and staff should stay home from school for at least 5 days and longer if necessary until fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication) and symptoms are improving.** Additionally, after isolation ends, students and staff should continue to take precautions as they resume normal activities by wearing a mask for 5 days. Please contact your school nurse if your son/daughter tests positive for COVID-19 within 24 hours.
