Eaton High School Scholarship Application

The Eaton Police Association is a non-profit organization that consists of police officers that serve the City of Eaton. Since 2013 the Association has raised funds to offer an annual scholarship of \$500 to an Eaton High School student pursuing the field of criminal justice, law enforcement, or law. Our goal is to assist the applicant in the pursuit of a career in criminal justice and to promote the importance of a college education.

Qualifications:

To qualify for the scholarship, the applicant must be enrolled in, or show proof they are preparing to enroll in, a college or university to pursue a degree in criminal justice, law enforcement, or law related field.

Application Procedure:

Applicants should prepare a letter of intent stating career goals and educational goals. The applicant should also describe in the letter at least one example of a time when their “hard work” paid off. Proof of enrollment as stated above, and three letters of recommendation should also be enclosed.

Interview:

Applicants who have submitted all requested materials will be requested to interview with board members of the Association prior to a recipient being named.
