WHAT IS AN ECHS SCHOOL?


As stipulated by the Texas Education Agency, ECHS schools are open-enrollment high schools that allow students least likely to attend college an opportunity to receive both a high school diploma and either an associate degree or at least 60 credit hours toward a baccalaureate degree. Early College High Schools enroll historically underserved students, target at-risk and economically disadvantaged students, provide dual credit at no cost, offer rigorous instruction, provide academic and social support services to help students succeed, provide students with highly personalized attention and intend to increase college readiness.

RECRUITMENT TIMELINE

Recruitment for the program begins in December. Interested students and their parents should participate in all ECHS recruitment events to learn more about the program. Applications for the program will be due the last day of February. Students will be notified of acceptance or waitlist via USPS mail during Spring Break.
