
# **Credential Information**

#### **Declaration of Need for 2023-24 School Year**

The deadline to submit the Declaration of Need form request for the upcoming school year is June 16. If we do not receive your Declaration of Need, we will not be able to process your applications for emergency type permits for the 2023-24 school year.

You may submit your school's Declaration of Need in one of the following ways:

#### Arts and Music in School Web Resource Now Available



The Arts and Music in Schools — Funding Guarantee and Accountability Act was recently established by Proposition 28 with the purpose of providing annual funding to K-12 public schools to supplement arts education programs. Guidance on the proposition can be accessed on the CTC website.

#### **Education Omnibus Budget Trailer Bill for Substitute Teaching**

The Education Omnibus Budget Trailer Bill that allowed flexibility with the extension of the number of cumulative days a substitute teacher can serve in the classroom for one teacher of record is sunsetting.

Effective July 1, the substitute service limitations for all holders of documents authorizing substitute teaching will be 30 days in a general education setting and 20 days in a special education setting. Substitutes may no longer serve for 60 cumulative days in either general or special education settings.
