

Board Minutes June 20, 2023

The Johnson County Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, June 20, 2023 in the board office at 6:00 p.m. Chris Fields, Kevin Brantley, Alvin P. Moorman, Donald Smith, and Marty Thompson were present. Chairman Fields called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Mr. Thompson gave the invocation and Mr. Brantley led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The following business was transacted:

1. The agenda was approved on a motion by Mr. Smith, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval.
2. The May 16, 2023 called meeting, May 16, 2023 regular meeting, and the May 23, 2023 called meeting minutes were approved on a motion by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Smith; unanimous approval.
3. The May 2023 financial report was approved on a motion by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Moorman; unanimous approval.

5. Superintendent Watkins presented the FY24 budget for final adoption. The final budget was approved on a motion by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval.

On a motion by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Moorman; unanimous approval was given for the following: aerate the ball fields by Lawncare Plus, replace damaged windscreen at the HS softball field based on quote from BSN Sports.
7. Superintendent Watkins presented the GSBA Award Process and the GSBA Strategic Planning Process. Both processes were approved on a motion by Mr. Moorman, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval.

On a motion by Mr. Smith, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval was given to go into executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee. After discussion, a motion was made to come out of executive session by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Thompson; unanimous approval.
