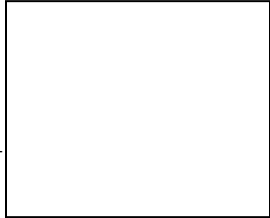

Severe Low Blood Sugar:

Child will be unresponsive, maybe convulsing and unconscious. **This is a life-threatening situation.**

If you find a diabetic in this condition:

- Assign some one to call 911 and Health Office extension: _____
- Put child on his/her side, protect the student's head, and **do not** put anything in his /her mouth.
- Give Glucagon injection: Mix entire contents of accompanying syringe full of diluting solution into the vial containing glucagon. Mix well and gently withdraw contents into the syringe. With needle pointing up discard all air and any excess solution, over prescribed amount, in syringe. Inject all of syringe contents into child's thigh, pause for count of five before removing syringe. (Note syringe is perpendicular to thigh)
- Remove Insulin pump needle from child
- Call parents
- Keep warm, on side; do not give anything by mouth. Vomiting may occur.

If child is uncooperative, possibly very slow to respond, lethargic and a known diabetic. Apply glucagon gel or frosting to gums if child is conscious.
