

University Requirements




- Four years of high school English

Out of State Universities

- Approximately 5,300 colleges and universities in the United States.
 - EACH has different admission requirements.
- Start looking at schools you might possibly be interested in to see their various requirements.
- Each calculates your GPA differently.


Tips for SUCCESS
