Letters of Recommendation

We as counselors truly enjoy the opportunity to celebrate students through a letter of recommendation. In order for us to write the best letter possible, it is necessary for students to have completed the following:

1. Personal Resume
2. Parent Brag Sheet
3. Student Brag Sheet
4. Optional Writing Sample (Choose Me Essay)
5. Information regarding deadline

Students should then make an appointment with their counselor for approximately 30-45 minutes.

After the student/counselor appointment, students should allow a **minimum of two weeks** excluding vacation time for the letter/form to be completed from the date of the interview.

Please note that counselors are **unavailable on days off/vacation time** to complete letters of recommendation.
