All applications must include the following:

- 1. Complete application with all documents and items of support.
- 2. Biographical essay MUST include career aspirations in the performing arts (100 words/full page minimum typed).
- 3. Two letters of recommendation from educators or employers.

The completed application MUST be postmarked no later than Friday, March 29, 2024.
