



MCNALLY GHIO ALUMNAE SCHOLARSHIP

The McNally Ghio Alumnae Scholarship is funded by the Villa Duchesne-City House Alumnae Association. The scholarship, named in memory of Sr. Mary Gray McNally and Sr. Nancy Ghio, is available annually to a student entering the ninth grade who meets the criteria shown below. Recipients receive \$5,000 towards tuition, and the scholarship is renewable each year of high school provided that the student maintains her eligibility. The recipient of this scholarship will be recognized at various times throughout her high school years.

McNally Ghio Alumnae Scholarship eligibility criteria:

- Student's mother, grandmother, or great-grandmother attended Villa Duchesne or City House;
- Student exhibits a strong desire and commitment to Sacred Heart education and traditions afforded to Villa Duchesne students;
- Student is well-rounded and meets the School's academic requirements for admission; and
- Student demonstrates financial need.

To apply for the McNally Ghio Alumnae Scholarship, the following are required:

- A completed McNally Ghio Alumnae Scholarship application (both student and parent questions are listed on the following page);
- A completed FIT (Family Individualized Tuition) application through FACTS. Learn more at www.villa1929.org/fit;
- A completed Villa Duchesne application (*new students only*, available at www.villa1929.org/apply);
- A completed Archdiocesan Catholic High School Application form indicating Villa Duchesne as the first choice for secondary education (*new students only*);
- Student visit day and parent meeting scheduled through the Admissions Office (*new students only*);
- Transcript and standardized test scores (*new students only*)
