<b>Hearing 2</b> November 18	<ul> <li>Held prior to release of draft maps</li> <li>Education and to solicit input on the composition of Trustee Areas</li> </ul>
<b>Hearing 3</b> November 29	Public Hearing for input on draft maps
<b>Hearing 4</b> December 6	Public Hearing for input on draft maps.
Hearing 5/Map Adoption December 12	Public hearing followed by Board consideration and map adoption
County Committee December 14	Kern County Committee on School District Organization




Federal Laws	Traditional Redistricting Principles

	□ Planned future growth





