# Anna L. Klein School Student Uniform Policy

The purpose of these regulations of a student uniform policy is to provide:

A. Pupils, parents, and staff members with a clear description of the district's expectations with regard to student uniforms.

#### Shirts

 Navy blue cotton-blended polo shirts bearing the Guttenberg School District insignia (short and long sleeve styles)

#### Pants

- Denim material, jeans, sweat pants, "leggings" and "jeggings" are NOT permitted.
- Khaki (Tan in color) Bermuda style shorts (knee length), skirts, (knee length), and jumpers (knee-length) are permitted.
- Clothing must be worn at the natural waistline.
- Colored tights or leggings may be worn underneath skirts in cold weather, but not in lieu of pants.
- Khaki shorts may be worn in September, May, and June must be appropriate fit and length.

#### Sweaters

- Sweaters that are blue or have the Guttenberg insignia may be worn.
- Only school spiritwear sold by Anna L. Klein school clubs may be worn.
  - No other sweatshirts other than the Anna L. Klein sweatshirts may be worn at any time.

#### Footwear

- Shoes must be securely fastened.
  - Clogs, flip-flops, bedroom slippers and ANY shoes WITHOUT a back are **NOT PERMITTED**.

#### Sizing

 Clothing must be sized to fit the student. Pants should fit appropriately and should not be too tight or too loose. Shirts should be appropriate size and should not extend below the hip. Skirts and shorts shall be no shorter than two inches than above the knee. Undergarments shall not be visible.

#### Headwear

 Students may not wear/carry hats, hoods, sweatbands, bandanas, scarves or sunglasses while in the school building.

### Face Coverings

- Due to the requirement set forth by the Governor of New Jersey and the New Jersey Department of Education, all students must wear a face covering in the school building at all times. (The only exclusion will be for a medical reason with documentation or otherwise written in an IEP for Special Education Students that cannot wear a face covering due to a disability).
- o Face coverings cannot contain any words, letters, symbols, or pictures.
- Face coverings can be different colors.

All transfer students have two weeks from day of enrollment to purchase and begin wearing school uniforms.

## **Violations of Dress Code:**

- First Offense: Parent/ Guardian will be notified by the school secretarial staff. Parent/ Guardian will be required to bring in the student's uniform. Student will be given a pass to class until their parent/ guardian has arrived.
- **Second Offense:** Parent/ Guardian will be notified by the school secretarial staff. Parent/ Guardian will be required to bring in the student's uniform. Students in grades k-2 will be given a lunch detention. Students in grades 3-8 will be given an afternoon detention.
- Third Offense: Parent/ Guardian will be notified by the school secretarial staff.
  Parent/ Guardian will be required to bring in the student's uniform. Students in
  k-2 will be given 2 consecutive days of lunch detention and a morning detention.
  Students in grades 3-8 will be given 2 consecutive days of afternoon detention
  and a Saturday detention.
