Parent-Teacher Conference Checklist

BEFORE



- Ask your child how they feel about school.
- Ask your child if they're is anything that they want your to talk about with their teacher.
- Tell your child that you and the teacher are meeting to help them.
- Prepare questions on:
 - participation
 - strongest/weakest subjects
 - homework
 - ways to help
 - social/emotional well-being

DURING



- Be on-time or early
- End meeting on time
- Relax and stay calm
- Bring your child
- Ask most important questions first
- Ask for clarification, if needed
- Make sure to check child's progress
- Leave updated contact information
- Thank the teacher

AFTER



- Talk about the conference with your child
- Talk about the positive points
- Be direct about problems mentioned
- Discuss plans and goals that were created
- Keep in touch with the teacher throughout the school year

GOALS FOR THE 23-24 SCHOOL YEAR

PERFORMANCE

- 65% of students will meet/exceed their NWEA fall to spring growth targets in both reading and math.
- MSTEP/PSAT8 proficiency will increase in both ELA and Math by 20% for grades 3-8.
- The overall college readiness percentages will increase by a minimum of 10% on the Spring PSAT assessment.

ATTENDANCE

- Chronic absenteeism will decrease by 15% in comparison to the 2022-2023 school year.

INTERVENTION

- Students will have an average mastery of 80% or higher of skills during scheduled intervention time.

Reading Support K-2

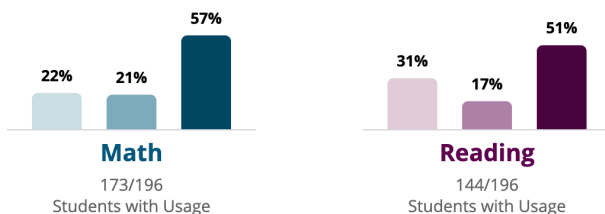

How Much Time Do Students Spend on Their Learning Paths?

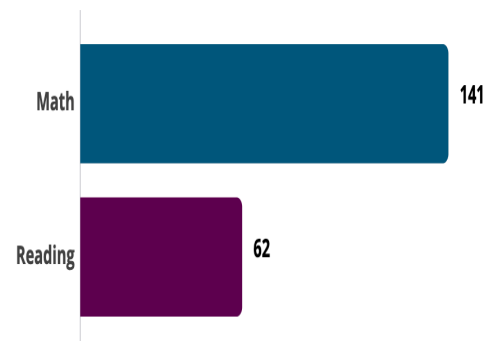
