- 1. Students should be graduating from grade 11/5th form in May 2024 and must be a Jamaican citizen.
- 2. Students should have the interest of furthering their education in a University overseas after graduating from AISK.
- 3. The minimum academic requirements are listed below, and applications will only be forwarded to the AISK Scholarship Committee if they are met:
 - GPA of 3.75 or higher
 - PSAT with a minimum score of 1000 or higher

- Based on first come, first serve basis
- Verifiable financial need
