Addendum to Food Allergy Awareness Guidelines - Special Considerations for COVID-19

- 1. With parent permission, a listing of children (including a photograph) with food allergies within the classroom shall be available in an easily accessed and consistent area within each classroom for lunch supervisors to reference.
- 2. Each child is to eat at his/her assigned desk only; moving about the classroom during eating times, or alternative seating assignments during eating times is not permitted.
- 3. Children with life-threatening allergies should be seated on the perimeter of the classroom and away from the door, if possible, to limit possible allergens in the lunches of other students. Additionally, students with life-threatening allergies should be seated away from the trash receptacle to prevent exposure as students dispose of their trash.
- 4. All classrooms where a child with life-threatening allergies will have priority adult supervision during the eating period.
- 5. Each student will eat their lunch at their desk on the provided paper barrier.
- 6. Trash receptacles will <u>not</u> be placed near students with life-threatening allergies.
- 7. Students with life-threatening allergies will clean off their desk with a single use cleaning device.
- 8. All students will undergo district approved allergy awareness training for lunchtime safety procedures (<u>F.A.R.E. PAL</u>, Cool Tools).
- 9. To limit exposure to both allergens and SARS-CoV-2, students will not eat snacks in the classrooms.
