"Mr. Jones helped motivate me to do my best in all my classes and to challenge myself. He guided me to the most challenging courses because he wanted me to do my best and give my all."



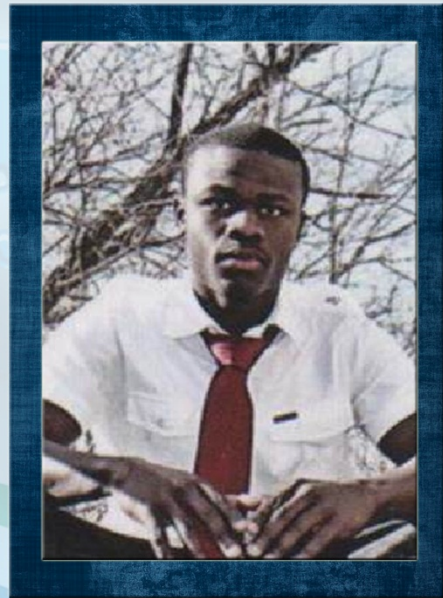


## Anthony Boateng
