

Congratulations to Vida Antolin-Jenkins (MSS 1969) who was recently honored on the occasion of her retirement from the Department of Justice.

After serving almost 33 years in the Federal service, Vida retired from the position of Senior Associate Deputy General Counsel for Intelligence. She was honored with the Department of Defense Medal for Civilian Career Service. Vidal served in the Department of Defense (DoD) Office of General Counsel, Intelligence Division, from August 2013 to August 2023. One of her proudest achievements was leading the DoD OGC team that drafted the legislation and enabling documents for the U.S. Space Force and for the U.S. Space Command.

Prior to moving to the Department of Defense, Vida served as a Captain in the U.S. Navy Judge Advocate General's Corp. In 2013, she retired from the Navy after serving 23 years.
