757 INSTRUMENT RENTAL

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to help off-set the cost of maintenance and replacement of school-owned instruments.

1. A fee will be assessed to those students using instruments.
2. The fee will apply to grades K-12.
3. Those students who qualify for free or reduced lunch under existing federal guidelines will be eligible for a waiver of fees.
4. No refunds will be given to those students who leave the program.
5. The fee is to be collected during the school year by the Music Director. The Director will receipt the money and fees are directed to the Business Manager.
6. All school-owned instruments that are rented shall be returned in the same state of repair as they were received. Any additional repairs or maintenance will be done by a reputable artisan and is the responsibility of the student.
7. Students shifting from one school-owned instrument to another school-owned instrument will only pay rental as agreed on the previous instrument.
8. Students shifting from their own personal instrument to a school-owned instrument at the request of their instructor will not be assessed a fee.
9. Students shifting from their own personal instrument to a school-owned instrument of their own volition shall be assessed the regular rental fee as stated.
