Ohio Graduation Requirements

The Ohio Department of Education

State law introduced new, permanent graduation requirements for students in the class of 2023 and beyond. Students entering ninth grade **after July 1, 2019**, must meet the new requirements outlined in state law.



#1 Course Requirements

English Language Arts	4 credits
Health	.5 credit
Mathematics	4 credits
PE	.5 credit
Science	3 credits
Social Studies	3 credits
Electives	5 credits

Students must also receive instruction in economics and financial literacy and complete at least two semesters of Fine Arts.

Fairport Harbor Schools also requires that students have 2 credits of a foreign language.

Total 24 credits



#2 Demonstration of Competency

Earn a passing score on Ohio's high school Algebra I and English II tests.

Students who do not pass the test will be offered additional support and must retake the test at least once.

OPTION 2.....

Enlist in the Military

Show evidence that you have signed a contract to enter a branch of the U.S. armed services upon graduation.



OPTION 3.....

Complete College Coursework (CCP)

Earn credit for one college-level math and/ or college-level English course through Ohio's free College Credit Plus program.



Third.....show readiness

Earn **two** diploma seals, choosing those that line up with your goals and interests. These seals give you the chance to demonstrate academic, technical and professional skills and knowledge that align to your passions, interests and planned next steps after high school.

***One **MUST** be a STATE seal and the second can be a state or a local seal

A. OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal (State) ***



Requirements:

1. Demonstration of professional skills, work-readiness, and work ethic competencies
2. Students must have at least a total of 3 mentors to validate the 15 professional skills needed to earn the Seal

B. Seal of Biliteracy (State)

Requirements:

1. The student must demonstrate a high level of proficiency in both English and at least one other world language
2. Students can demonstrate proficiency in English and at least one other world language through a series of test-based options.



C. College Ready Seal (State)

Requirements: (Junior year)

Earn remediation-free scores on the ACT or SAT (English=18, Math=22, Reading=22)



D. Science Seal (State)

Requirements:

Students can earn the Science Seal in one of three ways:

1. Proficient on the Biology test; or
2. Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate; or
3. Earning a “B” or higher in an approved CCP course



E. Honors Diploma Seal (State)

Requirements:

Meeting the criteria for one of six honors diplomas:

Honors Diploma

Career-Tech Honors Diploma

IB Honors Diploma

STEM Honors Diploma

Civics and Social Sciences

Fine Arts Honors Diploma



F. Citizenship Seal (State)

Requirements:

Students can earn the Citizenship Seal in one of three ways:

1. Proficient on American History and American Government Test
2. Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate
3. Earning a “B” or higher in approved College Credit Plus Courses



G: Military Enlistment Seal (State)

Requirements:

Students can earn the Military Enlistment Seal in one of two ways:

1. Providing evidence in an armed services branch of the military; OR
2. Participating in an approved Junior Reserve Officer Training (JROTC) program



H: Technology Seal (State)

Requirements:

Students can earn the Technology Seal in one of three ways:

1. Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate; or
2. Earning a “B” or higher in an approved College Credit Plus course; or
3. Completing a course offered through the student’s district or school that meets guidelines set by the Ohio Department of Education



I: Industry-Recognized Credential Seal (State)

Requirements:

In order to earn the industry-recognized credential seal, a student must:

Earn an industry-recognized credential that is aligned to a job that is determined to be “in-demand” in this state and its regions.



J: Community Service Seal (Local)

Requirements:


Completion of a community service project that is aligned with the guidelines adopted by the student's district board or school governing authority

Other requirements are locally-defined, meaning that each school or district may construct requirements for their own specific program



Community Service Seal (Local) con't

In order to earn the Community Service Seal at Fairport Harding High School under the Ohio graduation requirements for students in the graduating classes of 2023 and beyond, each student will need to complete a total of 100 hours of community service during their four years of high school. It is recommended that students complete 25 hours of community service each year. Students who transfer to Fairport Harding High School will only be held accountable for 25 hours per year of enrollment. Students will use the Community Service Form to document volunteerism, which needs to be signed by the volunteer coordinator and turned in to the School Counselor. During the Senior year, earned hours must be documented by May 1.

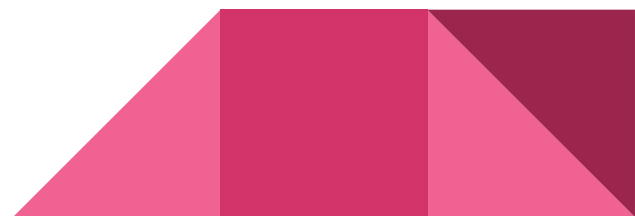

K: Fine and Performing Arts Seal (Local)

Requirements:

Demonstration of skill in the fine or performing arts according to an evaluation that is aligned with the guidelines adopted by the student's district board or school governing authority

Other requirements are locally-defined, meaning that each school or district may construct requirements for their own specific program



Fine and Performing Arts Seal (Local) con't

In order to earn the Fine and Performing Arts Seal at Fairport Harding High School under the Ohio graduation requirements for students in the graduating classes of 2023 and beyond, each student will need to complete 3 credits in the areas of Fine and Performing Arts with a grade of C or higher. Fine Arts courses include Art courses, theater, band, and any courses listed in higher education curriculum guides. If you are unsure if the course you are taking meets these criteria, please seek guidance from the school counselor.



L: Certified Student Engagement Seal (Local)

Requirements:


Participation in extracurricular activities such as athletics, clubs, or student government to a meaningful extent, as determined by the guidelines adopted by the student's district board or school governing authority

Other requirements are locally-defined, meaning that each school or district may construct requirements for their own specific program



Certified Student Engagement Seal (Local) con't

In order to earn the Student Engagement Seal at Fairport Harding High School under the Ohio graduation requirements for students in the graduating classes of 2023 and beyond, each student will need to complete 4 activities during their high school career in any non-academic program(s). Students who transfer to Fairport Harding High School will only be held accountable to complete one activity per year of enrollment. Students will use the Student Engagement Form to document participation, which needs to be signed by the advisor and turned in to Guidance. Activities may include any extracurricular activities such as athletics or clubs.
