

808 PROPANE STORAGE POLICY

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to limit propane storage tank to comply with Department of Homeland security regulations. Section 312 of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-Know act

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

- A. The policy of the school district is to comply with the new maximum limits of stored propane on or near schools. Plans and procedures to protect employees, students, volunteers, and members of the public who enter school district buildings and grounds Establish written procedures for the identification and management of stored hazards or potential hazards materials.

III. PROCEDURES

- A. Based upon recommendations from Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management. This administration will adopt and implement written plans and procedures to limit the Propane Storage Tank to 78% Max capacity for a total product weight not to exceed 59,529.6 pounds of propane. We will label the tank to address the new maximum limits.
- B. The school district shall monitor and make good faith efforts to comply with this and any new or amended laws, rules, or regulations to control potential hazards.

IV. PROGRAM AND PLANS

- A. For implementing this policy, the administration will provide a copy with local vendor who fills our tank. If at any time it is above maximum limits we will shift boilers to storage tank and use up any amount over 78%.
- B. We will label tank with new maximum limits of 78%

VI. ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement of this policy is necessary for the goals of the school district's health and safety program to be achieved.
