SUPPORT FOR YOUR DISTRICT

The CDEC provides Individual diagnostic evaluations conducted by an interdisciplinary team that includes a learning disabilities teacher/consultant, a school psychologist, and a school social worker.

The interdisciplinary process includes, but is not limited to, student observation, information from the student's parent/guardian, classroom teachers and individual team testing.

The CDEC services also include annual reviews, and triennial evaluations of previously classified students receiving speech correction and all other special education services.
