## 01 ACT

ACT College Readiness Benchmark Score on at least one of the following subtest:

English (18) - Reading (22) - Math (22) - Science (23)



## 03/04 AP/IB



International Baccalaureate®

Qualifying score on an AP Exam ( 3 or higher) or IB Exam (4 or higher)

## EARN COLLEGE CREDIT

Tuition free, during high school!



## 06 COLLEGE CREDIT

College or Post Secondary Credit:  
Minimum of 1.0 transcribed college / postsecondary credit while in high school. Minimum grade of "D" is required in order for credit to be posted to student college transcript



## 08 CTE CREDENTIAL

Earn an Industry Recognized Credential through a CTE Academy. The Lowndes County Career Technical Center offers more than ---- industry credentials through CTE Academies.

Any additional College and Career Readiness (CCR) indicator approved by the Alabama State Board of Education.

## CTE COMPLETER



Earn 3.0 or more credits in one CTE Academy and must earn a "C" or higher in each course.  
Max 1.0 Foundational Course  
Min. 1.0 Concentrator Course  
Max 1.0 CTE Lab, Work Based Learning or Pathway Project Course

## MILITARY ENLISTMENT



Enlist in a branch of the military before graduating high school. An official letter from the recruiter stating the student has enlisted in the military is required.
