Cell Phones and Watches

We have been seeing an uptick in the use of cell phones and watches during the school day. District policy states that cell phones must off or in airplane mode during the school day.

We have been reminding our students of this expectation and will be taking phones and watches of students who continue to use them. The devices will be stored in the office safe until the end of the school day. If students continue to violate our district policy, devices will be held until a family member is able to pick them up. We recognize that families have provided cell phones for their student for safety reasons and understand the reasoning behind this. Students may use classroom or office phones during the day with teacher permission. If students are feeling ill, they must report to the nurses office. The health room will then notify families of a student illness.

Cell Phone and Watch Guidelines

- Cell phones and smart watches are allowed on the bus so long as students are looking and listening to school-appropriate media. If you are listening to something, you must use headphones or earbuds or keep the volume off
- Once you are off the bus or out of your carpool, cell phones must be put into airplane mode and left in your backpack. They cannot be with you at any time during the school day. Cell watches must be put into airplane mode or put away and never used as a communication device during the day.
- You may use the office phone, or classroom phone with teacher permission if you need to contact your family.
- When you leave for the end of the day, your cell phones and cell watches may not be used until you or on the bus or picked up in the carpool area. If you need to speak with a parent, this should have been done earlier in the day. If it is an emergency situation, please ask a school adult for permission.
- If you are unable to follow these expectations, your phone or cell watch will be taken and kept in our school safe. You will be able to pick it up at the end of the day or your parent may be called and they will have to come to the school to pick it up.
