This week's theme: ***Traditions Around the World!***

Objectives:

- Learn about holiday traditions and how they are different from other holidays in countries worldwide.
- Form an understanding of what different holidays mean to different people and how this impacts us as individuals around the world.

Monday: Open discussion tradition game

Miss. Charlotte will read a story that goes over common traditions celebrated around the world.
Book Title: *Families Around the World* by Margriet Ruurs

Students will then draw a family tradition their family celebrates, once done drawing, each student will take a turn picking a friend to guess what their tradition is, once each student has a turn telling their tradition and guessing, we lastly review as a group traditions and holidays that are commonly celebrated around the world and how they impact us.

Tuesday: Holidays around the World team quiz

Miss Charlotte will open quizizz on her computer and project a holiday team quiz onto the classroom projector screen for students to see. (*Quizizz is a website used schoolwide for teachers and students for online quizzes*)

Students will then work in teams to answer questions in front of them to their best ability in one minute. Students will get to choose their traditional holiday team name and their team mascot, whichever team wins, gets to pick a prize from the prize box, and all other students will get to pick one piece of candy for participating.

Wednesday: Holiday Pictionary

Mrs. Jody will have different countries and their holiday traditions written on the whiteboard for students to see. Mrs. Jody will then go over each holiday in that country and a few things they celebrate. Mrs. Jody will then ask each student independently to pick which holiday they would like to draw and mark their name next to that holiday or country on her sheet of paper for her only to see.

Students will then take turns drawing a picture related to that holiday on the whiteboard for their friends to see while they guess which holiday they are drawing.

Thursday: Mexican Mirrors Art

Students will work with Miss Charlotte and Mrs. Jody to complete an art project for students

Friday: Review day

Students will take turns standing in front of the class to tell their favorite day of the week and what activity they enjoyed the most as well as one thing they learned. Students will then be allowed to play at their leisure.
