
OLGC has given us many blessings and memories, and The Cornerstone Project is one way we can continue to give back in thanksgiving and prepare for future generations to experience this incredible community.

In preparation for Christmas, we will offer a number of opportunities for reconciliation, prayer and worship.


Advent Evening Prayer will once again be held on Monday evening, Dec. 11 at 7:00, this week in the church.

#### THE CRECHE

By the time you read this, I will have put up my creche. It's an annual ritual I've observed ever since I was a young child. As we're all aware, people who are old like to tell stories. And why not? They've lived a long time, had many experiences, and want to share. That's what I'd like to do now—share the story of my creche.

When I was eight years old, my father made this stable, using a wooden crate that had once held liquor bottles. It's 3-sided, stained dark brown, and has a small opening on either side of it, much like windows. Across the back it has a tilted rack made of individually carved sticks, which holds an ample supply of hay which we got from a farm owned by a family friend. I still have a small bag of extra hay, the very same stuff we brought home from the farm so many years ago.

The creche was originally designed to hold our Christmas tree, which was always a lightweight balsam. The tree was placed in a metal holder in the middle of the peak of the roof. A gold star with downward rays is stuck into the roof. We covered the roof with cotton and artificial snow, and filled the structure with small figures my mother bought at Woolworth's. There's Mary, Joseph, and the Holy Infant in a little manger, kneeling angels perch inside along with two reclining farm animals, a dog and a couple of sheep. We put more cotton and snow on the outside of the creche where shepherds stand with their humble offerings, the Magi are off to the side with a camel and its attendant. And this is the way it was until we returned from a military tour in Japan when my parents gave me the creche to hold a place of honor in my own home.

When our son was in his teens, he decided to make wooden shingles for the roof. He went into the nearby woods, took the bark off of a fallen tree, and fashioned small shingles out of it, gluing and

overlapping them onto the roof of the creche. It was a full circle moment because little did he know his great-grandfather made wooden shingles for homes in his small Slovakian village so many years before.



I love traditions, and there are a good number of them in our family. This one, unpacking and setting up the creche, however, is almost sacred to me. I'm so grateful for what my father crafted out of an old wooden box so long ago...it was a labor of love. It evokes memories of Christmases past. But especially dear is the photo of our daughter, then about 2 years old, and my father lying on the floor in front of the creche. He was telling her the Christmas story of the night Jesus was born. It doesn't get any better than that!

I hope that you, too, have special stories to tell about your creches, and are passing them on to the youngest members of your tribe. Yes, I believe it's our job to be the story tellers in our families. Otherwise, how else will they know the richness and beauty of the tapestries that make us who we are?






