## Register Youth ORCA cards by December 31, 2023!

As a reminder, youth 18 and younger ride transit for free. For riders 13 and older, using a Youth ORCA card (also known as a Free Youth Transit Pass) is highly encouraged, but not required. Tapping a Youth ORCA card allows transit agencies to better understand how many young people are riding transit, including where and when.

**Youth who have a Youth ORCA card:** To ensure that their card provides free fare until they turn 19 years old and does not expire sooner, all cardholders should register their card at [FreeYouthTransitPass.com](https://www.freeyouthtransitpass.com) by **December 31, 2023**. This 2-minute process requires only an email address or phone number, Youth ORCA card number, and birthdate.

**Youth who need a Youth ORCA card:** Youth aged 13 and older are encouraged to order a free Youth ORCA card by visiting <https://www.myorca.com/buy-online/> (the card will automatically be registered when ordered).

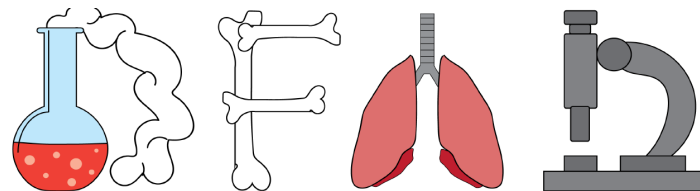
