ARP Act and ESSER III

March 2021, President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021

- → Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER III) Fund
 - safely reopen schools for in-person instruction and keep them open
 - address disruptions to teaching and learning
- → Oregon Department of Education (ODE) was allocated \$1.121 billion
- → ESSER III Fund grants can be used between March 13, 2020 and September 30, 2024
- → School required to use 20% of their ESSER III funding to address unfinished learning activities

Timeline

- March 11, 2021 President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021
- July 15, 2021 ESSER III State Application Approved
- August 27, 2021 Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plans due to ODE
- October 20, 2021 District ESSER III Funding Plans to ODE

- **Ongoing:** State and Local engagement with community
- September 30, 2024 Last date to expend ESSER III funds

Alignment of Multiple Plans

ESSER III planning is focused on the same strategies from our Learning Model, the **Student Investment Account** (SIA) and the Gresham Barlow **Continuous Improvement Plan** (CIP).



Community Engagement

ESSER III plan utilizes the community engagement process from SIA with 2 additional requirements:

- Migrant Students Reached out to families, students and the Family Engagement Specialist with Multnomah Education Service District (MESD) who runs the regional Migrant Education Program (MEP).
 MESD also sent out a survey to MEP families.
- Incarcerated Youth Every student currently on probation at the beginning of the 2021-22 school year was interviewed for the ESSER III plan.
