Total Hours needed to complete CTE credential

- No Credential: 136 hours
- Clear Single or Multiple Subject: 51 hours (via Bridge Program)
- Preliminary Single Subject (SS) or Multiple Subject (MS): 136 hours. Same as no credential.

- \$100 cashier's check or money order payable to the California Commission on Teachers Credentialing
- \$50 non-refundable application fee payable to UC Riverside Extension Center
- LiveScan Fingerprinting (\$65- \$85)
- High School Diploma or equivalent verification
- SDAIE Waiver- \$100 per year. Required for teachers with no credential. Not required for teachers with clear SS/MS
- Three years (3,000 hours) of work experience needed with at least one year of hands-on experience in the industry sector(s) listed on the credential and recency of one year in the last five years, or two years within the last 10 years.
 - One year equals a minimum of 1000 clock hours and the experience may be full-time or part-time, paid or unpaid.
 - **All applicants must provide verification of one year (1,000 hours) of work experience.**

- Official transcripts showing relevant coursework (48 semester units = two years of experience)
- Advanced industry certifications (can = one year of experience)

 - Orientation to Designated Subjects Credential Program (\$60, 1 hour)
 - Designated Subjects Core for SS/MS Credential (\$695, 50 hours)
- Official transcripts showing completion of:
 - Health Education
 - US Constitution
 - Copy of current CPR Card
- Verification of Teaching Experience (2 years teaching CTE w/ preliminary CTE credential). Employing district may provide a letter to verify the number of terms successfully taught or they may complete a form that will verify teaching time.
- \$100.00 cashier's check or money order payable to the CTC

Total Hours needed to complete CTE credential

- Clear Single or Multiple Subject: 40 hours
- Preliminary Single or Multiple Subject: 180 hours (same as no credential)

- SDAIE Waiver- \$100 per year. Required for teachers with no credential. Not required for teachers with clear SS/MS
- Three years (3,000 hours) of work experience needed with at least one year of hands-on experience in the industry sector(s) listed on the credential and recency of one year in the last five years, or two years within the last 10 years.
 - One year equals a minimum of 1000 clock hours and the experience may be full-time or part-time, paid or unpaid.

 - *Health Education for Teacher (\$275, 10 hours)
 - *CPR and Basic First Aid
 - *US Constitution course or examination
 - OPTIONAL- Advanced Professional Training for CTE Credentials: For CTE candidates who do not have 2 years of teaching experience. May be taken in lieu of 2 years teaching experience. (\$600, 40 hours)

Candidates with Clear SS/MS Credential

- Foundations of Curriculum (\$600, 40 hours)
- Official transcripts showing completion of :
 - Health Education
 - US Constitution
 - Copy of current CPR Card
- Verification of Teaching Experience (2 years teaching CTE w/ preliminary CTE credential **OR** completion of the Advanced Professional Training course). Employing district may provide a letter to verify the number of terms successfully taught or they may complete a form that will verify teaching time.
- \$100.00 cashier's check or money order payable to the CTC
