Dear Parent/Guardian and Student:

The Counseling Department, along with the administration, is in the process of scheduling for the 2023-2024 school year. Since scheduling will be done in PowerSchool, please use the PowerSchool Instructions and the Getting Started guides for middle school on Tahanto's website.

As most of you are aware, we offer 7 cycles per day for classes. Each student in the seventh grade is required to be enrolled in four core subjects: English, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies. A core subject is one that meets daily. These courses will be pre-filled for the students.

Grade 7 Students will also be required to take Physical Education for a full year, as well as Technology and Engineering. These classes run every other day for the full year and are pre-filled for the student as well.

Computer Science Discoveries, Middle School Essential Skills, and Science Fiction and Fantasy are required classes to be taken each semester and are pre-filled in the schedule as well. To complete the remaining schedule, every seventh grader must take an elective from the list below, depending on the space available in their schedule. Please select 2 Primary elective choices and 2 alternate choices.

Music Electives can be selected in Powers-School from the Music Elective category. These electives are not required

Students on Individual Education Plans should review the Special Services link to approve required academic services.
