## Our Goals for Student Achievement



### District Goals

Clayton County Public Schools sets goals for the entire district. The district goal for 2023-2024 is:

By the end of the 2024 school year, Clayton County Public Schools will increase the percentage of students scoring at the Proficient and/or Distinguished levels on the GMAS by at least 8 percentage points in each content area.

### MMS Goals

## In the Classroom

**MMS teachers will work with students and their families to support students' success. Some of the ways to connect with families are the following:**

Post classwork/homework assignments, resources, and announcements using Google Classroom.

- Offer online educational platforms for additional support.
- Assign content-specific homework at least 3 days per week.
- Input at least two grades weekly into Infinite Campus.
- Communicate with parents/families immediately to provide student updates on student progress.
- Implement Social-emotional learning
- Make real-world connections to the content.



## At Home

**MMS parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' success. The parents will do the following:**

- Reassure students by showing continuous support, being involved, and keeping students focused.
- Communicate with students to check for comprehension.
- Utilize/Provide additional resources.
- Communicate with teachers to address student progress and observations.
- Check Infinite Campus weekly to stay abreast of academic performance.
- Correlate subject to real life.



## Morrow Middle Students

MMS students joined with staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed. Students thought of the following ideas to make connections between learning at home and school:

- Come to each class prepared to learn and demonstrate personal best daily.
- Practice and study for at least 30 minutes content standards by completing assigned homework and utilizing online educational platforms for additional support daily.
- Access Canvas for classwork/homework assignments, resources, and announcements.
- Check Infinite Campus weekly to stay abreast of academic performance.
- Seek assistance from teachers, parents, and family members if needed for social and academic support.
