All students will be automatically billed for the second semester of the activities in which they are enrolled, unless an email is sent to afterschool@asbarcelona.com between January 22nd to January 26th, requesting any changes.

Please note that the players that signed up for the Saturday League in their sport will be automatically billed on January 26th for the second semester of the activity, as playing in the Saturday league requires a full year commitment.

Preference for the tournament and Saturday League teams will go to players who attend **both days** of practice and commit to playing in **both semesters**.

In the team descriptions, please note the **maximum enrollment** number for each activity. In grades 1-6, once the maximum enrollment is met, we will form a waiting list for the activity. In grades 7-12, once the maximum enrollment is met, we will hold tryouts for the team.

Students on sports teams are expected to be able to make the time commitment for their activity and remain in good academic standing. Students who are having difficulties in their coursework may be restricted from participation in practices and competitions.

Cross Country Running Club

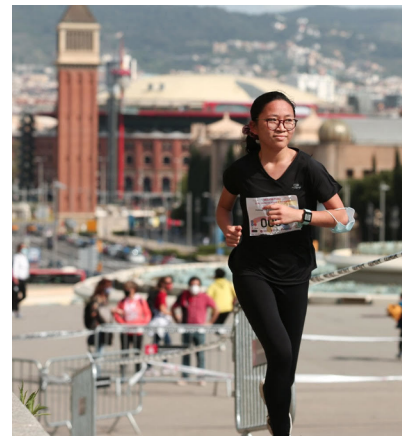
MS Cross Country Running Club Grades 6-8

LYNX Athletics Center

Fitness Grades 8 - 12 Maximum enrollment: 20 per day

ECC Art and Academic Activities (PK3, PK4, K5)

Gardening Grades PK3 - K5

Let's have some fun and get students involved with nature! Gardening has the power to teach the beauty of growing flowers and vegetables as well as valuable lessons like patience and self-confidence. Students will enjoy nature by planting many different flowers, vegetables, and fruits. We will watch them grow as we take care of our own ASB gardens. We will also explore how insects, seasons and weather affect plants throughout the school year. Let's get our hands dirty!



¡Jugamos y Aprendemos Juntos! Grades PK3-K5

This Spanish after school activity is geared towards language learners who wish to practice Spanish and reinforce what is taught in school through games, songs, and activities. The class is taught in Spanish from the first day and is taught by an ASB Spanish teacher.



French Grade K5

The French program is offered to our youngest students with the purpose of exposing them to a new language. The methodology is based on games, songs and entertaining activities combined with reading and writing exercises. From the first moment all the classes are taught in French.



Mini Chefs Grades PK3-K5

In partnership with MyGranChef, students will be able to experiment for the first time with different foods. They will learn about nutrition and creating a balanced plate, while exploring different textures, flavors, smells, and colors. Mini Chefs will not use any heating systems and the utensils are adapted to their age. All necessary health precautions have been put in place and students will use their own ingredients and utensils while cooking. Don't forget to bring a tupper to bring home a yummy treat after each class!



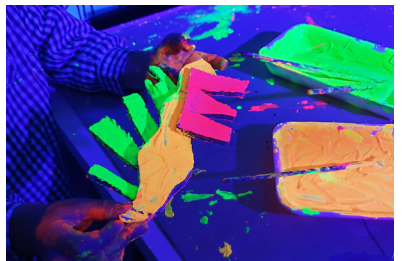

ECC Art and Academic Activities (PK3, PK4, K5)

Architecture and Design for Kids Grades PK4-K5

Let's have fun exploring the wonderful world of architecture and design together! In this course, taught by experienced artist and designer, our youngest builders will have the opportunity to be introduced to architecture, design and contemporary art. The course stimulates creativity, critical thinking, and improves their spatial perception and problem solving capabilities. Students will practice making models, building techniques, sculpture, land art and installation. The course is focused on experimentation using different materials including recycling, promoting awareness of sustainability through children's curiosity and creativity.



Art with Traç Grade K5 (extra cost)

This activity is offered in partnership with the prestigious Escola Traç. The course consists of different workshops: woodwork, basketwork, painting on glass, printing, engraving, card, stone, paper maché and 3-dimensional art using different materials. Students are introduced to different techniques and work on their own individual projects.

Lego Robotics Grades PK3-K5

Calling all builders! Students will build, investigate and learn how machines run and operate. Through the use of gears, levers, wheels, and axles, they will explore the exciting world of robotics and build the foundation needed to move on to programming.



ECC Yoga

A playful yoga activity designed for ECC students. Through stories and poses inspired by nature and animals, kids will develop flexibility, balance, and concentration. It nurtures their imagination while promoting a sense of calm and fun in an age-appropriate setting.

ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS

Elementary School Art and Academic Activities (Grades 1-5)

Chess Club Grades 1-5

This activity is taught by master teachers from the Escola Catalana d'Escacs. Students will be divided by level to develop and practice their chess skills. They will learn and practice an array of skills such as: focusing, visualizing, thinking ahead, weighing options, thinking abstractly, planning and juggling multiple considerations simultaneously.



Architecture, Design, Art & Tech Mon. Grades 4-5 Tues. Grades 1-3

Let's have fun exploring the wonderful world of architecture, art and design together! In this course, taught by experienced artist and designer **Natalia Morales**, our youngest builders will have the opportunity to be introduced to architecture, design, art & technology .

The course stimulates creativity , critical thinking, and improves their spatial perception and problem solving capabilities. Students will practice making models, building techniques and also exploring sculpture, land art and installation. The course is focused on experimentation using different strategies to make 3d models, prototypes learning basic concepts of electronics, mechanics, combining materials including recycling, promoting awareness of sustainability through children's curiosity and creativity.



Minecraft Code Club Grades 4-5

In Minecraft Code Club, students will work in the Minecraft Education Edition video game environment in order to develop descriptive and computational thinking (code) skills. Through an attractive narrative about THE FUTURE GLOBAL GOALS, in a fully gamified environment, students will carry out a series of missions as proposals from the social and citizenship fields. 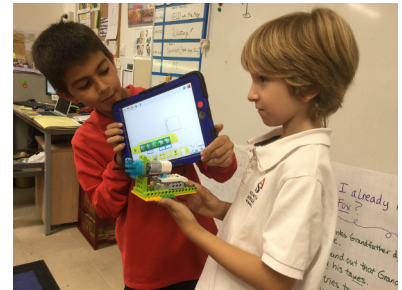
French Grades 3-5

Musical Theater Production and Spotlight Productions

ASB will run two full scale, professional musical theater productions this year - Spotlight Productions in Semester 1 and ES Musical Theater in Semester 2.

To offer the high quality theatrical experience, with professional sound, lights and costumes, the musical theater production prices are:

- **Semester 1 only** - MS/HS Spotlight will cost **530€** for the semester. This includes two weekly rehearsals, three weekend rehearsals and costume fee. Rehearsals run September to February with the show being at the end of the semester.
- **Semester 2 only** - ES Musical Theater will cost **530€** for the semester. This includes two weekly rehearsals, two weekend rehearsals, extended rehearsals nearer to the show date and costume fee. The show will be towards the end of May.

We do, however, require full commitment from the students and families in the musical theater productions, these are massive projects. Due to this we don't allow students to add, drop or change from these activities once they have started, therefore we can not offer refunds after the first two weeks. All parts are auditioned and leads need to have secure acting and singing skills. We adapt and modify scripts as we go along!

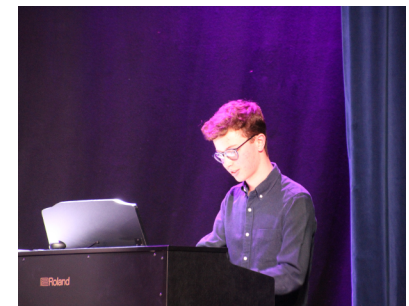
