CURA PERSONALIS & MAGIS ACADEMIC PROGRAM

We are committed to your son's success throughout his four years at Canisius High School.

The **Magis Academic Program**, based in our Center for Excellence, offers academic support in core subjects, including cohort-based coaching to meet unique learning needs. Staffed by a Director and veteran teachers, the program also coordinates learning opportunities beyond traditional classroom subjects, including life skills such as time management and digital citizenship. Because student mental health and wellness is of primary concern, a school psychologist and a clinical social worker specializing in stress resilience are available as additional resources to all students.

Everything at Canisius High School is centered around the idea of *Cura Personalis*, a Latin phrase meaning "care for the person." Canisius is committed not just to academic achievement, but also to mental and physical health, spiritual growth, and development of our students into citizens of the world. Our faculty, staff, coaches and moderators are dedicated to caring for students as whole persons.

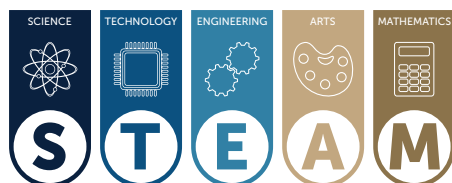

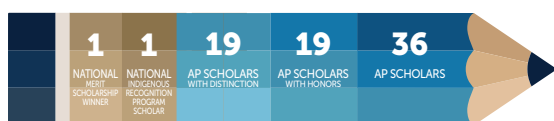
ACADEMICS

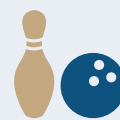
ATHLETICS

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS:

Canisius offers a number of academic scholarships to applicants who demonstrate outstanding academic achievement. These scholarships are determined by the applicant's transcripts from grades 6, 7, and 8, as well as his score on the Entrance and Scholarship Exam.

TUITION ASSISTANCE:

Need-based tuition assistance is also available. Families may apply for tuition assistance at the same time they submit a high school application and are notified of their award in their acceptance package.
