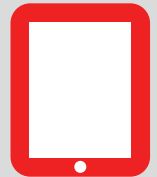

- JHS Book Rental will be sent to parents after student schedules have been secured. (September)



- Once you start the on-line process, you must complete in one sitting.
- Complete all of the screens to ensure that the school has enough information to serve your student.
- During the on-line window, it will take 24-48 hours for changes to be updated in PowerSchool.
- Ensure that the family has an active email address and telephone number in order to receive important messages from the school and corporation.
- Updating information in PowerSchool can be completed any time during the school year. This is especially important if you move during a school year.
