

# **TSIA Sign up Process and Intervention Expectations**

2023-2024

There are two ways to sign up for a TSIA test.

## **Option 1: Testing during school**

Taking a TSIA test this way traditionally only happens when the entire course needs to test (English I for TSIA ELAR; Algebra II for TSIA Math) or when the TSIA Advisory teachers certify that students are ready to test. Students will test in a designated area of the school.

Projected TSIA test dates for these are as follows:

- Friday, September 29th - TSIA Advisory Classes
  - English in the morning
  - Math in the afternoon
- Thursday, November 16th - TSIA Advisory Classes
  - English in the morning
  - Math in the afternoon
- Thursday, December 7th - All Freshmen ELAR testers
- Friday, February 23rd - All Sophomore ELAR testers
- Friday, March 1st - TSIA Advisory Classes
  - English in the morning
  - Math in the afternoon
- Wednesday, May 22nd - TSIA Advisory Classes
  - English in the morning
  - Math in the afternoon
- Thursday, May 23rd - All Algebra II students

The teachers of these courses will have spent time preparing students in the weeks/days leading up to the administration of the TSIA.

## **Option 2: Testing with a TSIA Success Coach**

Students can sign up with designated staff members on campus called TSIA Success Coaches (Mrs. Mote in 224 or Mrs. Bruns in FL1) on Wednesdays after school. The Coaches require students to complete a Google Form, picking their dates and times. Students are required to complete a certain amount of tutorials through advisory, Texas College Bridge, or through some other method before their requested test. If they are unsuccessful, they may complete more tutorials and try again at another date.
