To Be a Sophomore

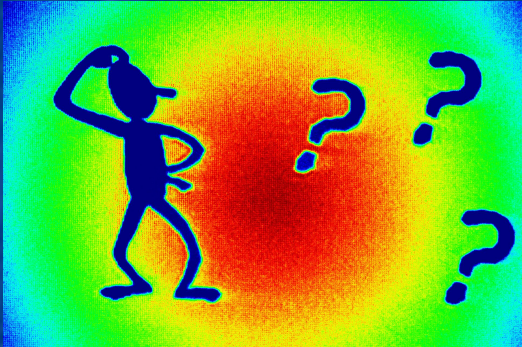
