



Importing JCampus Course Content to Sandbox Courses

Upon completion of the school year, you will want to import content from your completed JCampus courses into a Sandbox course so you can work within your Sandbox in preparation for the coming school year. The instructions below will guide you through importing content from your JCampus course to your Sandbox course.

1. Go to Canvas: <https://www.cpsb.org/canvas>.
2. Click on the sandbox course where you want to import content.
****If you need a new sandbox, submit a Tech Help ticket indicating the number of sandbox courses you need and the titles of each.***

3. From the Home tab, click **Import Existing Content**.

4. Next to Content Type, click the drop-down menu and select **Copy a Canvas Course**.

5. Be sure the box next to **Include completed courses** is checked. This will allow you to select both active and archived courses from the list in step 6.

6. Next to Search for a course, click the drop-down menu and select the course you would like to copy content from.

7. Click **All Content** and then click **Import**.

8. Under Current Jobs, it will show that the import has been queued.

9. Once the Course Copy shows completed, review your course to make sure the content imported successfully.

*If your import reports any issues, click *issues* to display a list. Then, click on the specific link to go to the area of the course with the issue.
