

Deseret Peak High School Boundary - Option #3




Stansbury High School

Boundary Proposals

- Elementary feeder schools are now Old Mill Elementary, Rose Springs Elementary, and Stansbury Park Elementary.
- The southern boundary west of SR-36 and east of Toms Ln has been extended to Church RD.
- The southern boundary east of SR-36 has moved further south from Mill Junction to Bryan Rd.






Stansbury High Student Summary


With the proposed changes the student population at Stansbury would be approximately:

- 410 students in 9th grade.
- 415 students in 10th grade.
- 424 students in 11th grade.
- 336 students in 12th grade.

The total student population would be 1,585 students, a decrease of 751 students from this year's current enrollment. Stansbury High's Maximum Student Capacity is 1,850.








Tooele High School

Boundary Proposals

- Elementary feeder schools are now Northlake Elementary, Settlement Canyon Elementary, and Sterling Elementary.
- The Gleneagles neighborhood has been moved to the Deseret Peak High Boundary.
- The area in between SR-36 and Broadway, and 1000 N and 500 N has been moved to the Deseret Peak High boundary.
- The area east of SR-36 north of the train tracks and south of Bryan Rd has been moved into Tooele High's boundary.
- The area east of Droubay Rd has been moved into Tooele High's boundary.






Tooele High Student Summary


With the proposed changes the student population at Tooele would be approximately:

- 389 students in 9th grade.
- 452 students in 10th grade.
- 378 students in 11th grade.
- 341 students in 12th grade.

The total student population would be 1,560 students, a decrease of 387 students from this year's current enrollment. Tooele High's Maximum Student Capacity is 1,850.








Deseret Peak High School

• Elementary feeder schools are now Copper Canyon Elementary, Middle Canyon Elementary, and Overlake Elementary.





Deseret Peak High Student Summary

With the proposed changes the student population at Deseret Peak would be approximately:

- 350 students in 9th grade.
- 291 students in 10th grade.
- 311 students in 11th grade.
- 292 students in 12th grade.

The total student population would be 1,244 students. Deseret Peak High's maximum student capacity is 2,000.
